Subject: **IMPORTANT Upcoming SGCC Laminated LABEL CHANGES (Reminder)**

Summary of Changes to Laminated Label (Tempered Label Requirements Remain Unchanged):

- Obsolescence of Standard & Heavy category (Thickness)
- Update to New (current) SGCC numbers
- Old SGCC numbers no longer accepted after July 1, 2025

Timeline for Implementation:

Certification Period	Plants
First Half of 2024 (F24)	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • New SGCC numbers issued (Not Active Until July 1,2024)
Last half of 2024 (L24) & First Half of 2025 (F25) CURRENT CYCLE	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • New Certifications active July 1, 2024 including updated listing & certificate views. Still allowed to use old SGCC numbers & logos.
Last Half of 2025 (L25) NEXT CYCLE	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • July 1, 2025 – Laminated Labeling Update Mandatory

Below are the minimum requirements for the SGCC Laminated Certification Label:

1. The correct SGCC number
2. At least one of the approved standards listed (unless a specific standard is included in the label, the product is not certified to that standard):
 - 16 CFR 1201 (and category I or II)
 - ANSI Z97.1-2015
 - CAN/ CGSB 12.1-2022
3. Certified Size (U or L), and Drop Height Class (A, B)

Examples of SGCC Laminated Label: NEW ABC Glass - Plant A (Optional)
(minimum requirements) 16 CFR 1201 II
SGCC (#### New SGCC Number) UA

*Note, no thickness designation present.

SGCC Laminated Label no longer accepted: ABC Glass - Plant A (Optional)
(minimum requirements) 16 CFR 1201 II
SGCC (~~#### OLD SGCC Number~~) UA
~~(H) or (S) Standard & Heavy category~~
